## 1. BEFORE CLASS:

- A. Prayer - God Working
- B. Preparation - You Working
- C. Have the Peace of God, No Unforgiveness.
- D. Have Consistent Godly Character in your Speech and Actions.

## 2. IN CLASS:

- A. Never Teach Alone.
  - 1.) You Need to Train Others.
  - 2.) What if there's an Emergency.
  - 3.) You Need an adult or youth Witness.
- B. Have Helpers Sit With the Children, not just Being at the Back.
- C. Change Locations every 10-15 minutes.
- D. Be Enthusiastic and they will too.
- E. Keep their Attention. Shut it down, if you Don't.
- F. Use Visuals.
- G. Have Incentives. (candy, stickers, praise, general thanks)
- H. Rowdy Children want Attention. Give it to them.
- I. Teach Responsibility for their Actions.
- J. Give Praise when they are Good.
- K. Listen to your Children.
- L. Hug and Touch the Children.
  - 1.) Encourages the Children.
  - 2.) Demonstrates the Love of God.
  - 3.) Imparts Spiritual Blessings of God
  - 4.) Men need to Be Careful.(I Thess. 5:22)

## 3. CORRECTION (Fair, Firm, Friendly, Forgiving)

  - 3.) Move a Helper to sit near or with them.
  - 4.) Separate them to another Seat.
  - 5.) Take the Child to their Parents.
