### II. SIX SYMBOLS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

#### 1. OIL-Leviticus 8:12, Psalms 23:5, Psalms 133:2

Leviticus 8:12 And he poured of the anointing oil upon Aaron's head, and anointed him, to sanctify him.

Psalms 23:5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

Psalms 133:2 It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments;

#### 2. DOVE-Luke 3:22

Luke 3:22 And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

#### 3. WIND-Acts 2:2, John 3:8

Acts 2:2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

John 3:8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

#### 4. FIRE-Acts 2:3-4

Acts 2:3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.  
4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

#### 5. WINE-Acts 2:15-16, Ephesians 5:18

Acts 2:15 For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day.

16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel;

Ephesians 5:18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

#### 6. WATER-John 7:38-39

John 7:38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive:...)

### III (a). CHARACTERISTICS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

#### 1. Father sends the Holy Spirit to draw us to Him-John 6:44

John 6:44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

#### 2. Born by the Spirit-John 3:5-6

John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

#### 3. Is our Comforter-John 14:16

John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

#### 4. Points us to Jesus Christ-John 15:26 & 16:13-14

John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come.

14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall show it unto you.

5. Tells us when we Sin-John 16:8

John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

6. Guides us into all Truth-John 14:26 & 16:13

John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come.

7. Helps us Remember all things-John 14:26

John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

8. Gives us the Character of God-Galatians 5:22-23

Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

III (b). CHARACTERISTICS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN BAPTISM

9. Gives us Power-Acts 1:8

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

10. Gives us a New Language-Acts 2:4

Acts 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

11. This Builds our Faith-Jude 20

Jude 20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

12. This Helps us Pray the Will of God-Romans 8:26-27

Romans 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

27 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

13. We don't understand our prayer, but God does-I Corinthians 4:2

I Corinthians 4:2 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.

14. This Helps us to Worship-I Corinthians 14:15

I Corinthians 14:15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.
