Ephesians 6:4:

(from New Testament from 26 translations)

"Fathers provoke not your children to wrath.....

fret not your children to anger

vex not your children

don't overcorrect

do not irritate your children

must stop exasperating your children

do not rouse your children to resentment

must not goad your children to resentment

"But bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord!"

but nurture them in the chastening and admonition

but bring them up with Christian discipline and instruction

in such training and correction as befits the servants of the Lord

with the sort of education and counsel the Lord approves

which belong to a Christian upbringing

but raise them by letting the Lord train and correct them.
